- Budget total 2021-2022 : environ 10 millions \$ (incluant l'action humanitaire)








# WHERE ARE WE WITH DEVELOPMENT FINANCING?




As % of GNI

**ODA in 2021 on a grant equivalent basis - as a percentage of GNI**






**Graphique 1 | Volume des dons en Suisse de 2003 à 2021**

# CHANGES & CHALLENGES

---




**IVCO**  
SENEGAL 2022

- Shift from uni-directional (North->South) to multi-directional volunteering
  - Funding scheme needs to be rethought
- Fragilities: Covid-19, conflicts, shrinking space for civil society
  - Vulnerability of project-based volunteering funding
- Growing requirements from donor countries
  - Costs for quality management and compliance are increasing
- Risk of decline in state and private funding from donor countries
  - Increased competition for funding



# ADAPTATION

---



- Strengthen funding by national or regional bodies at the programmatic level (core contribution for multiple countries/themes or by country or theme rather than by project)
  - Resilient: Relatively stable, flexibility for funding between projects
- Shift from an impact model based on international volunteering to a model based on civil society strengthening
  - Development impact becomes paramount to the form of intervention (volunteering)



The Impact Model of Unité combines development activities at three different levels. Capacity development strengthens individuals as well as organisations and institutions in the partner countries, enabling them to improve their living conditions autonomously.



- Advocating for the achievement of the Financing for Development targets



- **DONORS MUST PRIORITIZE CORE CONTRIBUTIONS**


